

My ballot envelope was opened and resealed by the Watertown Township Clerk's Office. Why?

A misprint was discovered on ballots for precincts 1A and 2C (Grand Ledge School District), which required an additional instruction insert be included with the ballot. Some of the ballots were already sealed and ready to be mailed, which required clerk staff to open them to include the insert and then reseal the envelope. In those instances, we affixed a sticker indicating this on the ballot envelope. If your ballot does not have this sticker, it was not opened and resealed.

The insert that was added is below:

Dear Voter,

After ballots were printed, a typo was discovered in the heading for the office of Grand Ledge Area District Library. The header should have read, "*Vote for not more than 4*" candidates instead of "*not more than 2*".

In an effort to avoid incurring the additional cost to reprint the ballots, which would have also resulted in the delay of the delivery of ballots, we are informing of this typo. You may cast a vote for up to **four** candidates in the race for Grand Ledge Area District Library, if you desire.
