Ordinance No. 54

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO PROHIBIT MARIHUANA
ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP BOUNDARIES.**

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WATERTOWN ORDAINS:

Article 3, Section 28-3.7 – Prohibited uses, generally, is hereby amended to prohibit recreational marihuana establishments within the township’s boundaries. The aforementioned amendment is to Chapter 28 of the Code of Ordinances, Charter Township of Watertown, Clinton County, Michigan.

28-3.7 PROHIBITED USES, GENERALLY

Uses not specifically permitted and uses not clearly similar to permitted uses in a district, as determined by the zoning administrator, are hereby prohibited. Medical marihuana dispensaries, and medical marihuana facilities as defined in the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act, being Public Act 281 of 2016, including growers, processors, secure transporters, provisioning centers and safety compliance facilities are hereby prohibited in all districts and class B home occupations not expressly permitted in a zoning district are prohibited in that district. MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS, AS THAT TERM IS DEFINED AT MCL 333.27953 ARE COMPLETELY PROHIBITED WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP’S BOUNDARIES AND ARE A PROHIBITED USE IN ALL ZONING DISTRICTS. A MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENT DOES NOT INCLUDE THE TRANSPORTATION OF MARIHUANA THROUGH THE TOWNSHIP.
